



RED OAK YOUTH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



Red Oak Youth Football Association (ROYFA) may grant scholarships for registration fees to children who without this financial assistance would not be able to participate in our program. Red Oak Youth Football scholarship program focuses on providing opportunities for area youth to participate because of the physical, mental, and character-training benefits this program can provide. Scholarships are available to cover the cost of registration and uniforms.

The scholarship committee, which includes the ROYFA Board, will consider all complete applications received by the application deadline. The amount of the scholarship awarded (if any) may be a partial or full scholarship depending on the number of applicants, and amount of scholarship funds available. Scholarships are limited to one per registrant and are only valid for one season, therefore, athletes must reapply for each year they are requesting assistance.

ROYFA is a non-profit organization with very limited amount of funding available for scholarships and no guarantee of assistance is implied in this application.

Requirements for eligibility:

- Athletes must be age 12 or younger and must reside within the Red Oak School District or nearby areas within Ellis County with approval.
- Commitment to attend a minimum of 80% of scheduled practices and games.
- Participation by an adult family member in at least **10** hours of voluntary service to ROYFA during the sport season.
- Application must be completed by a parent, guardian, or head of household, with all requested information provided. Incomplete applications will not be considered. The application is on the following page.
- Families are required to participate in any fundraisers offered by the program.
- Scholarship requests must be submitted to ROYFA no later than June 1st, prior to the regular registration deadline.

Application Process:

- Complete the Youth Athletic Scholarship Application Form and must be signed by a parent/guardian.
- The ROYFA Board will contact you prior to registration closing.

Other Important Information:

- Scholarships will be provided on a first-come, funding and space available basis.
- Transportation to programs is not provided.
- The ROYFA program is able to provide scholarships based on the number of donations per season.
